

## **Refuse disposal**

Please sort your rubbish and dispose of as much of it as possible before the end of your stay, through the kerbside collection scheme.

**Refuse collection day is Friday:** Please put all bags, including any left in the garage, and the green food waste bin at the entrance to the drive **by 7am on Friday mornings**. Details of the collection schedule are on the notice board in the utility room. See Swansea Council website ([www.swansea.gov.uk](http://www.swansea.gov.uk)) for changes to collections after bank holidays.

## **Recycling**

PLEASE SORT YOUR RUBBISH – ONLY A LIMITED AMOUNT OF NON-RECYCLABLE RUBBISH WILL BE COLLECTED. There is a supply of green and food recycling bags in the utility room and the large pink recycling bag for plastics is in the garage. Please put a note out for extra recycling bags if stocks are running low.

**Food waste: Collected every week in small green bin which is outside near the garage.**

There is a small green food waste caddy in the utility room with special degradable liners to help keep it clean. Please do not use ordinary plastic bags to line this bin.

What to put in it: all kitchen food waste, including small bones.

## **On 'Green Weeks'**

**Green bags are collected fortnightly on green weeks**

Clean glass (but not broken glass), cans and aluminium foil should be put together in one green bag. Paper and card should be placed in a second green bag.

## **'On Pink Weeks'**

**The pink recycling bag is collected fortnightly on pink weeks**

Clean plastic bottles, plastic yoghurt pots, bottle tops, margarine and ice cream tubs etc. All these items should be clean. Do not use this bag for crisp packets, plastic bags, plastic film, bubble wrap, used cling film or polystyrene. Plastic items for recycling should be placed loose into the large pink recycling bag (found in the garage).

**Black bags (collected fortnightly on pink weeks)**

All other non-recyclable rubbish should go in the black bags.

The number of black bags that will be collected is strictly limited to 3 per fortnight, so please try to recycle as much as possible.
