Important information for guests at Barcud Lodge

Keys

As well as the front door key in the KeySafe, we provide an additional front door key, a set of keys consisting of a front door key, a key to the right hand garage up-and-over door, and a key to the garage side door. Please use the KeySafe if the keys provided are insufficient. You have been advised of the KeySafe code by Home from Home. When you leave, please ensure you put the key back in the KeySafe and the other keys on the hooks by the front door. Please also ensure that the back door is locked.

Gates

You will probably see sheep and ponies wandering through the village. Please keep the gates to Barcud Lodge closed so as to keep the animals out.

Parking

Please do not park on the grass. Our LPG (gas) tank and a disused septic tank are under the grass at the front and would not support the weight of a vehicle.

Broadband

We provide broadband free of charge, subject to reasonable use.

Network name and password are on the back of the router, which is in the lounge near the front window. You can also scan the QR code on the back of the router to connect your device.

Telephones

We do not provide use of a land line. Mobile phone coverage is very patchy in Gower, but O2 gives a good signal at the house.

Garage

Please use the garage for storing surfing equipment, muddy boots etc. There is a bucket and scrubbing brush in the garage and an outside tap with a hose (near the back door) if you want to clean wetsuits, surfboards, boots etc.

Laminate Floors

Please soak up any spillage on the laminate floors immediately as they can be damaged by penetration of liquids.

Windows

Please take care when opening side hung windows in windy weather and ensure that the window stays are fixed securely on the pins. The window stay locks are quite stiff to unlock, so please do not lock them, except in the upstairs toilet where there is no separate handle on to close and lock the window. The locks on the window handles all operate by turning anti-clockwise to unlock. The blinds have quite long pull cords; if you have small children please use the cord tidies to make sure they are not a hazard

Table Tennis

You are welcome to use the table tennis table in the garage, but you do so at your own risk. Please read the notice on the cupboard in the garage and ensure that children are always supervised in the garage. There are table tennis bats and balls in the caddy at the side of the table.
